Prof. Lijing Wang works at RMIT School of Fashion and Textiles, Australia. He received his PhD degree from the University of New South Wales, Australia. He worked as a Postdoctoral Research Fellow at RMIT University in 1999 and 2000, followed by more than 8 years working at Deakin University as the Research Academic, then Senior Research Fellow. Since 2009, he returned to RMIT University. Prof. Wang currently leads the Materials and Products research theme at RMIT WEFT Research Centre. He has been the chief investigator in more than 40 funded research projects. His publications reached more than 260 with citation H-Index 50. He is in 2% of top-cited scientists worldwide. Professor Wang is the Research Leader in the research field of Textile Engineering in Australia. His key research areas of interest are smart and high high-performance textiles; wearable technology; protective garments; clothing comfort; fibres and polymers material science, engineering and modelling; material functional design; and clothing supply chain sustainability.
